I. Food Pantries and Your Health

Access to nutritious food is one of the most important foundations for health and well-being—especially as we age. Having enough to eat not only helps maintain strength and independence but also reduces the risk of chronic conditions such as diabetes, heart disease, and high blood pressure. For many older adults and families in our region, community food pantries are a vital resource that can help bridge gaps and ensure that healthy meals are on the table.

Food pantries operate on very different schedules depending on each organization's **capacity, funding, staffing and volunteers, and the needs of their local community**. This often means that pantry hours and days of operation can feel disjointed or difficult to track. At the same time, many households are experiencing increasing pressure from **rising food costs, job instability, and economic uncertainty**.

This **Food Pantry Calendar Tool** was developed by the Atlanta Regional Commission (ARC) Area Agency on Aging (AAA) metro-Atlanta Senior Hunger Coalition as one more tool to support older adults and families in navigating these challenges. It reorganizes vetted food pantry collected and maintained by the Atlanta Regional Commission Empowerline (ePRO) team into a **visual, weekly calendar format**. By laying out pantries by day of the week, it makes it easier to see when and where food is available in your county.

The idea for this calendar came directly from the **growing number of food insecurity calls** received by ARC's Aging and Disability Resource Connection (ADRC) counselors and Coalition partner agencies. These calls highlight not only the increased food needs in the community, but also the reality of **limited funding, reduced staff capacity, and persistent home-delivered meal (HDM) waitlists**.

By showing pantries in a **calendar format—with visual cues** for requirements like appointments, proof of residency, drive-thru only, or home delivery—we hope to make it easier for older adults and caregivers to:

- Plan transportation in advance
- Bring the correct paperwork
- Know what to expect at the pantry
- Avoid the frustration of being turned away

While food pantries may not solve every challenge, they serve as an important bridge to nutrition support. This calendar is designed to help you connect with those resources more easily, supporting your health, independence, and dignity. Use this calendar as a guide to help you or someone you support with access to food quickly and confidently.

II. Instructions

How to Use the Atlanta Regional Food Pantry Calendar

This calendar helps you find food pantries across the Atlanta region. It is organized by **county** and shows pantries in a **weekly calendar format (Monday–Sunday)**. Each listing includes the pantry's **name, hours, and requirements**.

Step 1: Find Your County-specific Calendar

Each of the following sub-section is labeled with a **county name** (e.g., Clayton, Cobb, Fulton).

The "Metro-Atlanta Regional" section includes food pantries that serve **all 10 metro-Atlanta region** (Cherokee, Clayton, Cobb, DeKalb, Douglas, Fayette, Fulton, Gwinnett, Henry, and Rockdale counties). Use this list in conjunction with your county-specific list of food pantries.

Step 2: Look at the Weekly Calendar

For each county calendar, pantries are shown under the **day of the week** they operate.

Example: Under "Tuesday" you may see several pantries, each with their open hours listed.

Some pantries appear on multiple days if they operate more than once a week.

Step 3: Understand the Pantry Icons

Each pantry listing may include **icons** that explain requirements or services.

The **legend** at the top of each county tab explains these icons.

 Appointment required (call ahead or schedule online)

 ID required

 Residency or zip code restriction

 Household paperwork required

 Home delivery may be available

Step 4: Plan Your Visit

Write down the **day, pantry name, and hours**.

Check the icons to see if you need to **bring ID, proof of residence, or make an appointment**.

If you are unsure, call the pantry before visiting.

Step 5: Review Service Additional Notes

Below each calendar is a table with additional details about the listed pantries (such as phone number, address, and additional eligibility details).

Make sure the pantry you select serves your area.

Schedules may change: Pantry hours and days may vary, especially around holidays. Always call ahead if possible.
